PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO M.Phil.(CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY) AND PROFESSIONAL DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES, 2024-25

1. REGULATIONS:

The following are the regulations for admission of students into M.Phil.(Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology Courses/institutions as per G.O.Ms.30, HM&FW(C1) Dept, Dt:14-02-2025 in Colleges / Institutes affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences for the academic year 2024-25.

2. NUMBER OF SEATS:

The number of seats available for admission into M.Phil.(Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology Courses for the academic year 2024-25 in INDLAS HOSPITAL, D.NO. 29-7-32, VISHNU VARDHANRAO STREET, SURYARAOPET, VIJAYAWADA are as follows :-

3. DURATION OF COURSE:

i.M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology)

- This is a full-time clinical training course providing opportunities for appropriate practicum and apprenticeship experiences for 2 academic years, divided as Part-I and II.
- As per existing regulations of the University, the maximum duration to complete the course shall be four years from the date of admission.

ii. Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology

- Admitted candidates shall undergo the training (theory and practical) on full-time basis for duration of one year and complete all the course requirements, and appear for the final examinations. However, in the event of not completing the course requirements on time or failing in the final exam, a student is allowed to appear in the supplementary exam after completing 3 months of additional training at the department.
- As per existing regulations of the University, the maximum duration to complete the course shall be two years from the date of admission.

4. GLOSSARY OF TERMS:

The following definitions apply unless the context requires otherwise: -

- "Act" means the Andhra Pradesh Educational institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act.No.5 of 1983).
- Competent Authority means the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada.

- iii. Entrance Test Committee means the Committee constituted by the Competent Authority to look after the duties from the date of issue of notification for Entrance Test to till issue of Hall Tickets as per the guidelines prescribed by the Competent Authority.
- iv. Evaluation Committee means the Committee constituted by the Competent Authority to process for release of results of Entrance Test conducted for the purpose as per the guidelines prescribed by the Competent Authority.
- v. "Committee for admissions" means the committee constituted by the Competent Authority to select and make allotment of candidates to Professional institutions offering M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology in the State for admissions in accordance with the provisions laid down.
- vi. Common Entrance Test means the examination conducted for assigning rank on merit to the candidates which will be the basis for admission of the candidates into M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology courses applicable for both under Competent Authority Quota and Management Quota conducted by the Competent Authority.
- vii. Competent Authority Seats means the seats earmarked from out of the sanctioned intake of seats in each course to be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by the Competent Authority.
- viii. Management Quota seats mean the seats earmarked from out of the sanctioned intake of seats in each course to be filled in the manner as prescribed in these rules towards Management Quota.
- ix. Local area means the territorial jurisdiction prescribed for identifying the local candidate for Competent Authority Quota seats as per Presidential Order, 1974.
- x. Local Candidate for Competent Authority Quota seats as per Presidential Order, 1974.
- xi. Qualified candidate in respect of Competent Authority Quota and Management Quota seats means as prescribed under these rules.
- xii. Qualifying Examination means minimum educational qualification as prescribed under these rules.

5. ELIGIBILITY:

- i. The eligibility criteria for Admission into M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology courses shall be as mentioned below:
- ii. Nationality and Domicile: The candidates should be Indian Nationals or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders who got registered as PIO/OCI before 04.03.2021.
- iii. Candidate should satisfy local / non-local status as per Presidential Order, 1974.
- iv. The above clause (iii) is not applicable for the seats meant for Management Quota.

6. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

6.1. APPLICATIONS:

- i. In order to register for the OMR Based Entrance Test for admission into M.Phil.(Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology Courses, the candidates need to visit the website <http://drnr.uhsap.in>.
- ii. The candidates have to apply through online mode and the online application form will be available on the website <http://drnr.uhsap.in> from **11.00 AM on 17-03-2025 to 01-04-2025 upto 11.30 P.M.**
- iii. The candidates are advised to take a printout of the prospectus / instructions to fill the application form before proceeding to fill the application form.
- iv. The candidate should fill the online application form with the data required- for, through any computer with internet connection (home/internet café/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the relevant scanned original Certificates, Scanned Photo and Signature in the .jpg/.gif format separately.
- v. The fee can be paid through Debit card/Credit card or Net Banking.
- vi. The fee paid by the applicants is not refundable / transferable under any circumstances.
- vii. Read the Notification, Prospectus/Regulations carefully.

8. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

- i. All the candidates seeking admission into M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology courses should appear for an Entrance Examination conducted by Dr NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.
- ii. Entrance Examination will be conducted in a single day as notified.
- iii. The Entrance test shall contain 90 multiple choice questions (Objective type) with four responses.
- iv. The duration of Examination is 90minutes.
- v. The medium of Question Paper shall be in English.
- vi. Each question will have four options (i.e. A, B, C, D) out of which the correct/ closest option (A/B/C/D) is only to be identified in the OMR sheet.
- vii. Each answer with correct response shall be awarded one mark.
- viii. There is no negative mark for incorrect response.
- ix. Zero mark will be given for the questions not answered.
- x. Candidate should mark appropriate answer through the pen provided
- xi. Indicating more than one response will be deemed as incorrect response and will be given zero mark. The maximum marks will be computed to 90.
- xii. Candidates are not allowed to take back the question booklets and any request for the issue of Xerox copies of question booklets/answer sheets/keys will not be entertained.
- xiii. All eligible candidates shall appear for Entrance Test. Only the candidates who qualify in the Entrance Test are eligible to appear for interview.
- xiv. Minimum marks required to qualify in the Entrance Test shall be as per Regulation-5(d).
- xv. The merit list for the qualified candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test subject to Regulation-10.
- xvi. The answer key will be released after completion of Entrance Examination and objections, if any should be sent to the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada by e-mail ntruhsmpilpdcg@gmail.com in the prescribed proforma vide **annexure-VI*** of the regulations on or before the date and time specified.
- xvii. Mere permission to appear for the Entrance Test does not guarantee for admission unless she/she fulfills all the eligibility criteria as laid down in prospectus at the time of counseling.

NOTE :In case of equality of ranks after application of first ranking criteria, the second ranking criteria shall be applied. In case of equality of ranks after 2nd ranking criteria, 3rd ranking criteria i.e age shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given higher place in the merit list.

11. **HALL TICKETS:**

- i. The eligible candidate shall download the Hall Ticket through online from 10.00 AM on **14th April, 2025** from the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in> by entering his/her Registration ID and Date of Birth as (DD/MM/YYYY).

- iii. University takes all precautions for issue of Hall Tickets to all eligible candidates. In case if any candidate who fulfilled all stipulated conditions and not able to download the Hall Ticket, such candidates are advised to meet the Convener, Entrance Test Committee/Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health sciences, Vijayawada at least one day before commencement of Entrance Test by submitting all particulars such as registration number, date of birth, copy of online application. University will not be held responsible for complaints received through mail or any other mode or complaints received in any form after the Entrance Test is over.

13. **ENTRANCE TEST RESULTS:**

The list of provisionally successful candidates along with their marks, categories and ranks will be notified in the University Website and institute concerned.

14. **RETOTALING OF MARKS:**

Any candidate who wishes to have re-totaling of marks, should apply in person to the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada on or before the date specified by, enclosing a fee of Rs.2000/- by a crossed demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, payable at Vijayawada.

15. UNFAIR MEANS IN THE ENTRANCE TEST:

- i. Hall Ticket is not transferable. Hall Ticket should not be tampered.
- ii. A person should not impersonate a candidate.
- iii. Except Hall Ticket & Photo ID, candidate should not possess any Pen, Pencil, Papers, Books or Notes or Written notes or any type of electronic gadgets like Pagers, Cell Phones, Computers, Calculators, Bluetooth etc., on her/his clothes, body or table or chair, in to the examination Hall / Center.
- iv. Candidate should not talk to another candidate or person inside the examination hall.
- v. Candidate should not show his/her OMR Sheet to another candidate or he/she should not receive, attempt to receive help from any source, including consulting books, notes or papers or any other matter outside the exam hall or has given help or attempted to give help.
- vi. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of duration of the examination.
- vii. On completion of answering the questions, he/she should seek permission of the invigilator and leave the hall, only after handing over OMR Sheet, copy of Hall Ticket and Photo ID to the invigilator.

16. VIOLATION OF ANY ONE OR ALL OF THE ABOVE INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED AS MALPRACTICE

- i. Any candidate resorting to malpractice in the Entrance Examination will have his/her examination invalidated and will be disqualified from appearing for Entrance Examination for the next 3 years.
- ii. If a person impersonates a candidate, he/she will be disqualified from appearing for any Entrance examination for five years and if he/she is not on university rolls, will not be admitted to any course for five years and the criminal case will be lodged against him/her in the police station, the candidate who is impersonated also will be disqualified for 5 years.
- iii. Any items such as Calculators, Pagers, Cell Phones, Computers, Bluetooth or any other electronic gadget found with candidate will be seized and will not be returned.

16. INTERVIEWS:

- i. Interviews will be conducted for 10 Marks on the following topics:

- ii. Candidates who qualified in the Entrance Test have to attend for Interview as per the schedule notified by the University. Candidates attending interview have to make their own arrangements. No expenses will be borne by the University.

18. MODE OF SELECTION:

- i. Candidates who secure marks not less than 50% (40% in respect of SC /ST/BC) in the common entrance examination will only be called for Interview. Selection will be based on overall merit based on marks secured both in the Entrance Test and Interview. Candidates called for the interview should bring all the original documents along with a set of self-attested copies of the same.
- ii. The schedule for conduct of interview will be notified through University website.

19. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSIONS:

TO FILL UP COMPETENT AUTHORITY SEATS

- i. Committee for admissions shall be constituted by the Competent Authority under these rules.
- ii. The candidates who are qualified to seek admission as a consequence for obtaining rank in the Common Entrance Test and desirous of seeking admission into M.Phil Clinical Psychology or Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology shall register through online mode duly payment of Counseling Fee as prescribed by the Competent Authority and shall attend for Interview as per the schedule notified along with all the relevant documents including a copy of rank card issued.
- iii. List of Registered candidates shall be displayed and called for Interview as per the schedule notified by the Competent Authority
- iv. The University shall verify the relevant original documents submitted by a candidate at the time of interview.
- v. The final selection list shall be published on the university website based on cumulative merit among entrance test marks and interview marks.
- vi. Admission procedure shall be notified by the Competent Authority.

22.3. RULES APPLICABLE FOR COMPETENT AUTHORITY (CONVENOR) QUOTA

22.3.1 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF CANDIDATES WHOSE DOMICILE IS ANDHRA PRADESH

- The candidate shall satisfy Local / Non local status as per G.O.P.No.646 Education (W1) Department dated 10-07-1979 and Presidential Order. The procedure indicated in the above G.O. for Selection of candidates as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009 shall be followed.
- The Andhra Pradesh Non-local (APNL) candidates are eligible for 15% Unreserved seats only. The Local candidates are eligible for both 15% of Unreserved seats and 85% respective Local Area seats.

22.3.2 RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

Admission to 85% of the available seats shall be reserved in favour of the Local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 as given in Annexure-III of G.O. (P) No. 646, Edu.(W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979.

22.4 LOCAL AREA:

- The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam (Andhra

- University Area) shall be regarded as the local area for the purpose of admission to the Andhra University, and to any other education institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- ii. The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore (Sri Venkateswara University) shall be regarded as local area for the purpose of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

22.5 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.

- i. If he/she has studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.
- (or)
- ii. Local Status Certificate issued by MRO for claiming as Andhra Pradesh local as per Circular Nos. 4136 /SPF & MC /2015-5, dated.08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated.20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129,dated.28.10.2019 of General Administration Dept.

22.6 A CANDIDATE WHO IS NOT REGARDED AS A LOCAL CANDIDATE UNDER SUB-REGULATION (21.5.i) ABOVE IN RELATION TO ANY LOCAL AREA SHALL,

- a) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:
- b) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years. Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods.

22.7 THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES OF CANDIDATES ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION UNDER 15% OF THE AVAILABLE ANDHRA PRADESH UNRESERVED SEATS.

- i. All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh. Candidates who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of 10 year excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parent have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- ii. Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Education institutions other similar quasi-Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- iii. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, public sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.”

N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years.

- ii. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the leftover seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates by merit.

23.3 PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSIONS

- i. Committee for admissions shall be constituted by the Head of the Institution (INDALS Hospital, Vijayawada) under these rules.
- ii. The candidates who are qualified to seek admission as a consequence of obtaining rank in the Common Entrance Test conducted by the Competent Authority and desirous of seeking admission into M.Phil. Clinical Psychology or Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology Courses shall register as per the notification issued by the individual institute and attend for Interview along with all the relevant documents including a copy of rank card as per the schedule notified by the Head of the Institution (INDALS Hospital, Vijayawada).
- iii. List of Registered candidates shall be displayed in the website of the Institute and called for Interview.
- iv. The Committee for admission shall conduct interview duly verifying the relevant original documents submitted by a candidate at the time of interview.
- v. The final selection list shall be published on the Institute website based on cumulative merit among entrance test marks and interview marks.
- vi. The Head of the Institute shall issue provisional admission to the selected candidates as per the recommendations of the Committee for Admissions.
- vii. The Head of the Institute shall admit the candidates duly following the regulations of the University.
- viii. The selected candidate shall submit all original certificates during the joining in the course along with University fee as follows:

- ix. The head of the institute shall submit compliance to the University regarding the list of candidates joined along with University fee.

24. POWERS OF SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee for admissions shall have power to review the provisional selection in case of any errors, mis-representation, fraud or gross injustice. In all matters relating to the selections and admissions, the decision of the Committee for admissions shall be final and binding on the candidates and selections cannot be questioned after closure of admissions.

25. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course shall normally commence with effect from the date notified by the University. The duration of the course shall be calculated from the date of commencement of the courses and shall be uniform to all the candidates irrespective of their individual dates of admission.

26. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

- i. The admissions shall be closed one month after commencement of course.
- ii. Any vacancy existing as on the date of closure of admission or arising after the closure of admissions shall not be filled.
- iii. Candidates shall abide by the rules and regulations of Rehabilitation Council of India / Dr.NTR University of Health Science, Vijayawada issued from time to time.

27. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:

The Principal/Head of the Institution of the respective college/institute shall verify the authenticity of the documents. If satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees etc., immediately.

28. TUITION FEE:

All the candidates selected are required to pay the tuition fee as prescribed by the Government from time to time.

29. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

Not with standing anything contained in these regulations, the Head of the Institution may, at any time either suo-moto or on an application made by any person, after due and proper enquiry, if she is satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission, may, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order, cancel her admission, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why her/his admission should not be cancelled.

Against any such order of the Head of the Institution an appeal shall be with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.

30. POWERS OF Dr.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences may either suo-moto or on application made to them call for to examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof, made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, regularity or propriety of such order in relation thereto as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made provided that the University may, before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority and to the person effected to show- cause against such cancellation.

31. FINALITY OF SELECTION:

All selections made under these rules shall be subject to any general rules or orders that may be made by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences/ Government from time to time.

Final approval of admissions will be issued by the University after completion of admissions.

32. BOARDING AND LODGING:

All should adhere to the institutional rules and violation of rules will be viewed seriously.

33. BREAK OF STUDY AND RE-ADMISSION:

If a student absents continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his/her application in prescribed format by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Principal. Regulations for readmission after break of study along with application format and

fee payable is available in the university website. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfilled the regulatory conditions, they may submit applications through the Principal of the College by paying the fee.

34. WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE:

If any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions or in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit the request through the institute concerned along with course discontinuation fee Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) and GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft.

35. ATTENDANCE:

- I. Course of the study must, unless special exemption is obtained, continuously be pursued. Any interruption in a candidate's attendance during the course of study, due to illness or other extraordinary circumstances must be notified to the Head of the Institution/concerned authority and permission should be obtained. Under any circumstances the course must be completed within 4-yr from the date of enrollment.
- II. A minimum attendance of 80% (in a year including in all academic activities) shall be necessary for taking the respective examination.
- III. Thirty days of causal leave, maximum of fifteen days per academic year, shall be permitted during the two-year course period.

36. LEAVE:

Each year students will be permitted to avail 30 days leave. No Post Graduate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. In case the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave or unauthorized absence is beyond 30 days in a year the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period. No other leave is permitted.

37. UNIFORM:

All the candidates are expected to wear the Uniform on duty prescribed by the respective College.

38. COURSE OF STUDY:

The candidates admitted into M.Phil.(Clinical Psychology) and Professional Diploma in Clinical Psychology Courses shall pursue the study in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi.

39. EXAMINATIONS:

The candidates shall have to appear for such examinations as prescribed by the Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi / the University, from time to time.

40. ANTI RAGGING ACT

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act No.26 of 1997, dt.21-8-1997. The Anti ragging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.
